



# Pescheria di Rialto

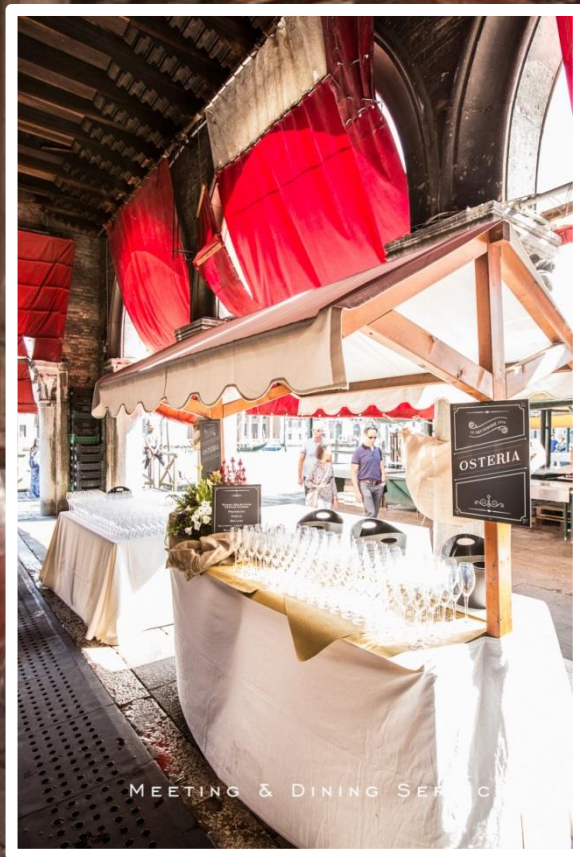
In the heart of Venice



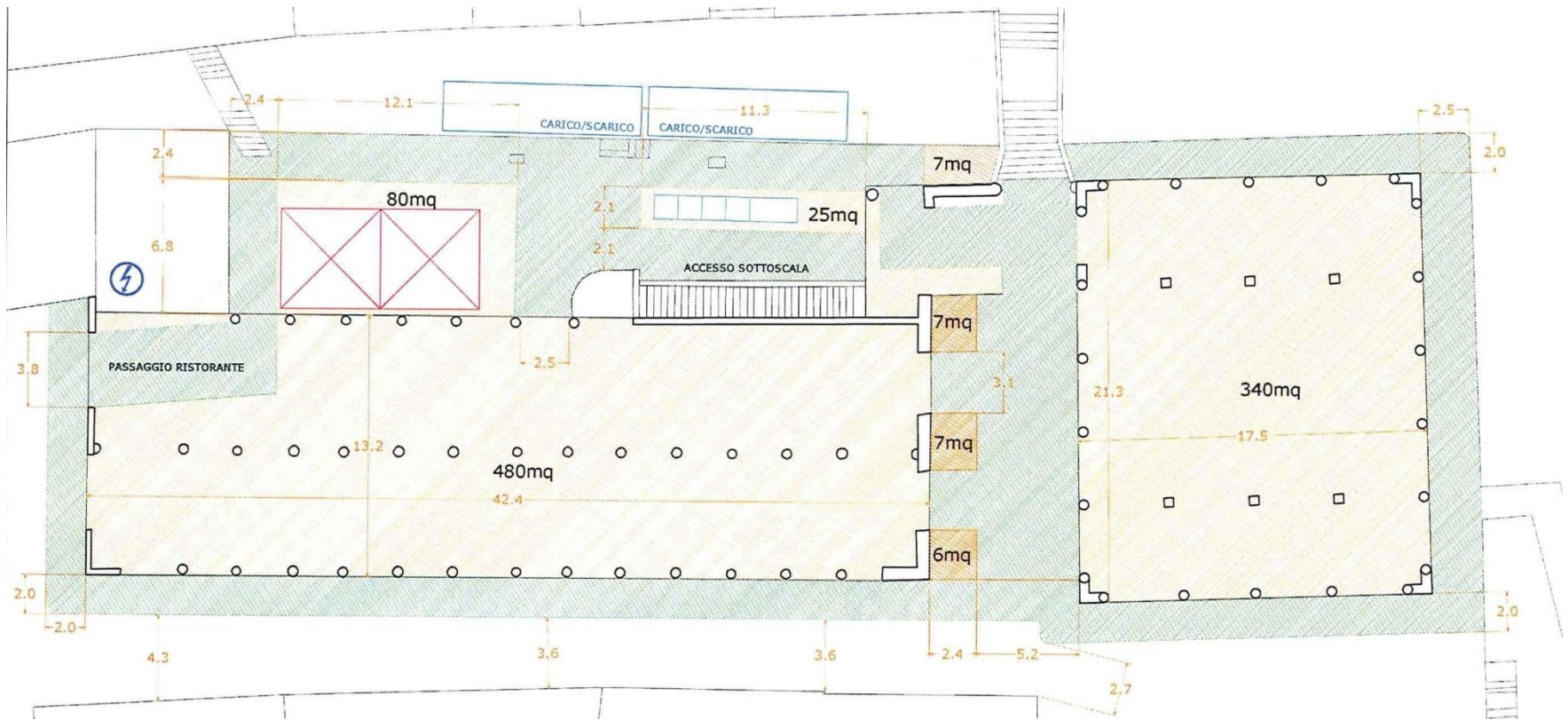
Rialto is the oldest centre in Venice. It is known for its market and bridge with the same name. The earliest information about this area goes back to the Early Middle Ages when people running away from the hinterlands during the Barbarian invasion, settled on the Rialtine islands. The date of the first settlement, called *Rivoaltus* was recorded as the 25th March 421. The market started in 1097. The mid 1500's saw a reconstruction of the market with new buildings which we can still admire today. The setting has become a meeting place for market stalls selling vegetables, fruit, meat, fish, cheeses, and above all, jewellery, precious items, and spices from the East. Over the ages, Rialto has maintained its commercial aspect, and is still now, animated daily by the traditional fish, fruit and vegetable market stalls and modern shops.

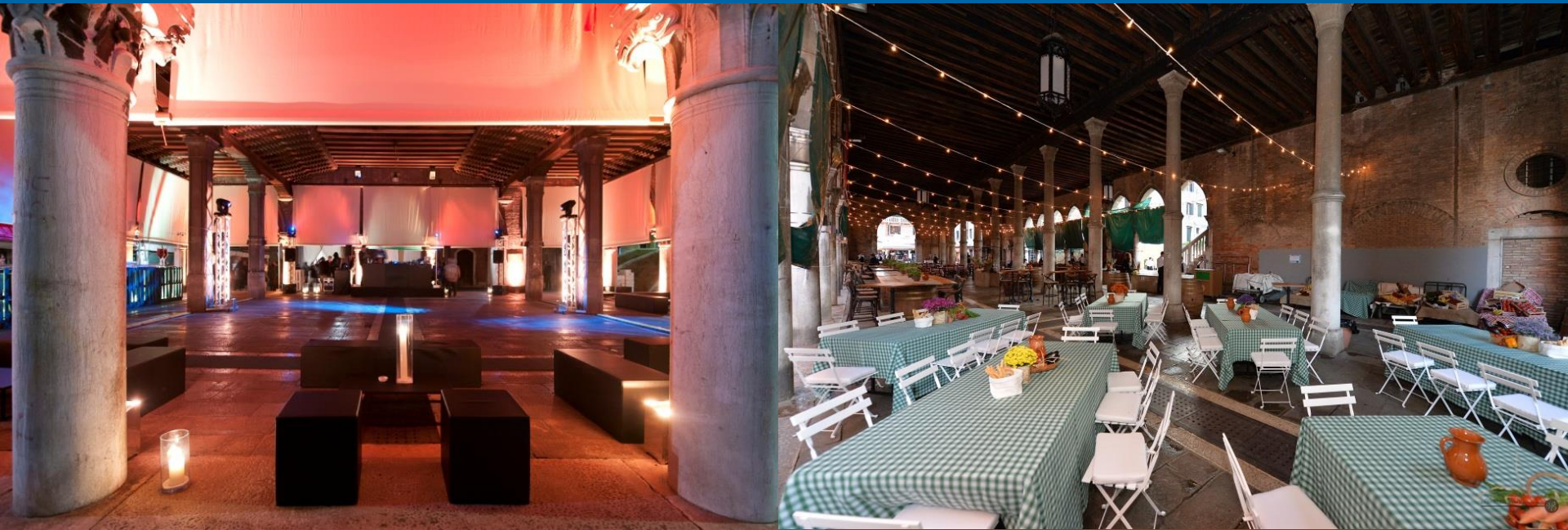

# Gala dinner and special events

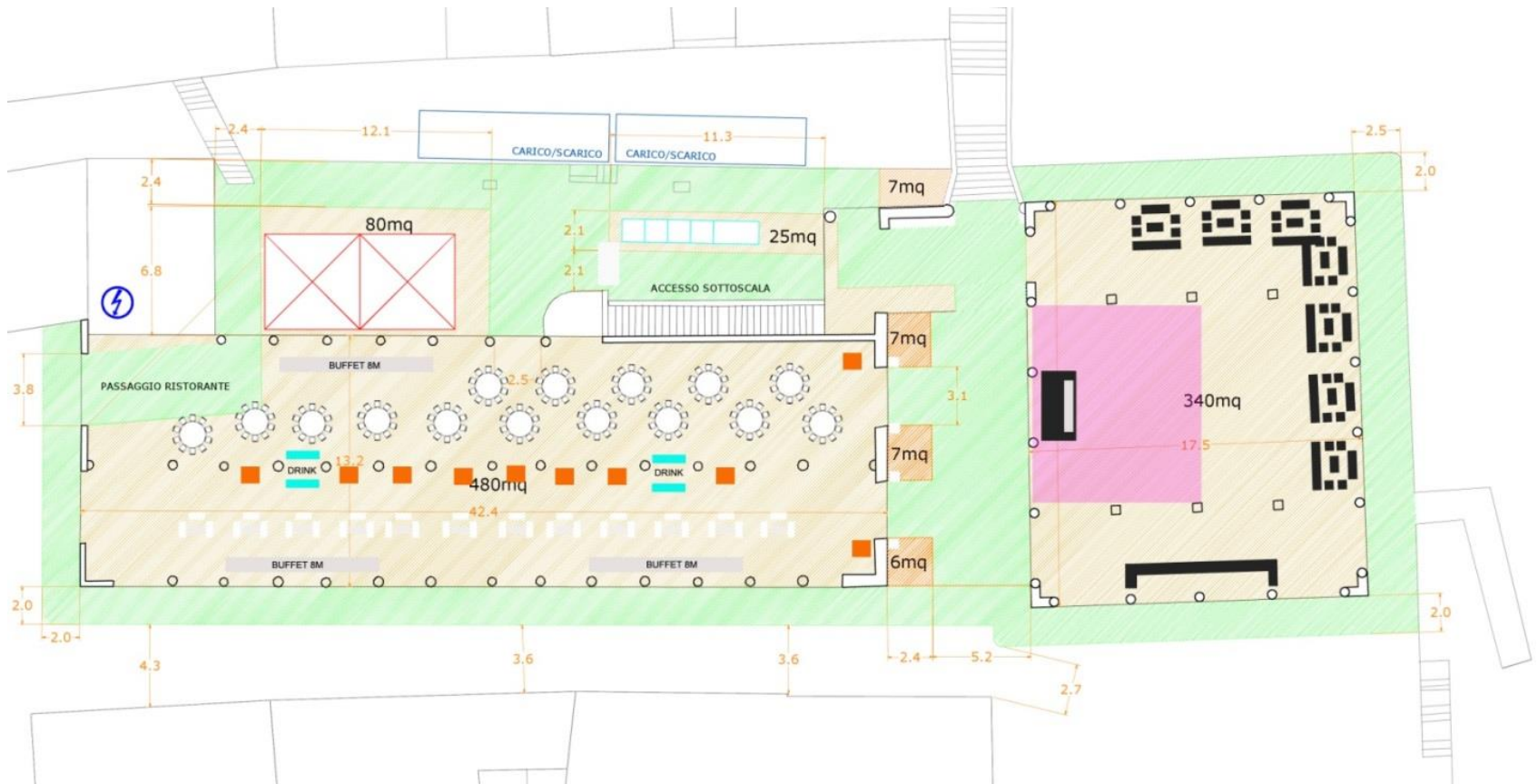

# Arrangement

The two loggias alongside (480 and 340 sq. meters) may be outfitted as kitchen and restroom areas.

These fixtures and fittings can be especially organized, to be compatible with safeguarding the architectural wealth.



# Logistics

In case of loading and unloading operations, the 'Pescheria' area is easily accessible by boat along the Grand Canal. At the same time, space for backup boating can be organized.
